This training will provide **school administrators** with an overview of **AB800, and Workplace Readiness Week**, which requires that schools integrate workplace rights into their curricula. As part of this recent legislation, all high schools across California need to distribute a fact sheet on worker rights, and develop a week of curricula and/or extracurricular activities focused on workplace readiness for 11th and 12th graders.

Join the Labor Occupational Health Program for training, during which we will provide an overview of what is required under the law, direct administrators to associated resources, and review curricula you can integrate into your schools. An Educational Program Consultant from CDE will be present to answer questions. Participants are encouraged to attend to submit any questions they have about the law in advance.
